



Y-Farms Dog Training Packet

This packet is designed to give you helpful information about our facility and how things work. We welcome all questions or concerns about your pooch while staying with us! While in our care, we strive to provide your pup a safe and fun experience!

Proof of Rabies, Bordetella, and DHLPP vaccines are required for all dogs on our premises.

*Please note that our facility is located on our family farm, steps from our home. We ask that you please respect the customer hours. Please be sure to schedule an appointment prior to arriving. **

- ❗ **Customer Hours:** Monday-Friday: 8:30am-5:30pm, Saturday: 9am-2pm, Sunday: 2pm-4pm. All pick-ups after 2 pm and all pick-ups on Sunday will be charged for a full day of boarding. Additional fees will be added if an early check-in or late check-out is needed.
- ❗ **Tours:** Due to COVID-19 and with the safety of our employees and clients in mind, we are not offering tours until further notice. Check out our virtual tour on our website to view the kennel facilities.
- ❗ **Vaccinations:** We must receive a current copy of your dog's vaccination records to ensure he/she is up to date on all required vaccines. These copies must be either be emailed to jen@y-farms.com or delivered in person at drop-off.
- ❗ **Drop Off / Pick Up:** Our automatic gate will be closed, please wait a few moments for us to open it. Please DO NOT honk, we have a motion-censor driveway alarm that will alert us of your arrival. Once the gate has opened, please drive slowly down the driveway to the white boarding facility. The gate opens & closes for ONE vehicle at a time, please do not tailgate or speed through it. Y-Farms is not liable for any vehicle damages caused by malfunctions of the gate. An employee will be outside to greet you. If an employee is not outside to greet you, there is a doorbell located at the front of our kennel building, and someone will be out to greet you shortly.

Please do not enter the facility without an employee present.

- ❗ **What to Bring:** We provide bedding, bowls, and training supplies. Please bring any heart worm and flea/tick preventative or any other medications that your dog is taking at home. Most dogs who train with us use our dog food (Victor Performance) but you are welcome to bring your dog's food from home. Please be sure to label all food containers. Y-Farms is not responsible for damaged or lost items.
- ❗ **Medications:** If your dog has any health or medical issues, let us know at drop off. If your dog has medication, make sure to have your dog's name and dosage instructions written on the bottle and on their paperwork.
- ❗ **Non-Spayed / Neutered:** We will allow non-neutered males to train with us; however, he will be monitored closely with other dogs. If there are any signs of harassment or aggression, we will kennel and air him separately for the duration of his stay. You must inform us if your female dog is in "heat" or due to come in "heat", so we can take extra precaution while she is in our care.
- ❗ **Payment:** We accept Cash, Checks, Venmo, & Credit Cards. Each Credit Card payment will have a transaction fee of 4.5% applied to the total. Please make checks payable to Y-Farms Kennels.



Frequently Asked Training Questions:

1. What are your hours for drop-off and pick-up?

We schedule drop off and pick up by appointment Monday through Sunday. Please contact us at 225-301-0175 to schedule an appointment.

2. If we wanted to drop our dog off for training, when could we get started?

Usually, we can get your dog in within a couple of weeks. Sometimes there is a short waiting period. It really just depends on when you contact us. We also take reservations for future dates, for instance if you are planning a vacation and you would like the dog to be trained while you are away. Our advice is to email us as soon as you know your vacation date.

3. Do you work with older dogs?

Yes, we have successfully worked with dogs over five years of age. We can help you with your dog.

4. What will my dog be doing when he is not training?

The dogs are out and about most all day every day. They are in their kennels for dinner time and for rest time. After training each dog will be allowed to unwind on one of our 5 dog yards. During inclement weather, the dogs are brought into our indoor kennel building, where they can enjoy some free time or rest. Unlike other training kennels, we do not force the dogs to stay in an enclosed kennel all day. We believe that they need free time to unwind and just be a dog.

5. Do you train all of the dogs with an electronic collar?

Over the years, I have trained many dogs without an e-collar. The collar is such a wonderful tool if used correctly. We do not "teach" with the e-collar. We use the collar to "reinforce" what your dog has already learned. We train all dogs with a collar metal chain collar (choke chain) a leash and a 20 ft. check cord.

6. What is your opinion on using treats as rewards during training?

We will often use treats when working with puppies. For many dogs, the fastest way to their brain is through their stomach, so food treats are often an effective way to reward behaviors as they are being taught.

7. My dog will be entering for 1 month of the Training program. Do I need to bring her dog food?

We feed Victor Performance Dog Food to the dogs that are training at here at our kennel. If your dog has food allergies or a sensitive stomach, please provide the dog food that your dog has been eating at home. Be sure to bring enough for the entire stay. If you would like us to switch your dog over to our food during his/her stay please bring some food, so that we can slowly switch over to our food.

8. Will my dog forget me while being away during training?

While a new bond will be established with the trainer, your bond to your dog will remain strong. Your dog will be busy learning new & exciting things while training with us. We will provide you with frequent updates on your dog. Once your dog is wrapping up his training, we will schedule one on one time with you to go over training. We will work with you & your dog together. Once your dog smells you and hears you, she will immediately recognize you. He will be thrilled to see you!

9. Will training change my dog's personality?

Training changes your dog's behavior but not his personality. Training helps organize your dog's thought processes so that he can have more self-control and respond to commands.

10. Will training help to correct my dog's undesirable habits such as digging and destructive chewing?

Training teaches the dog to respond to commands when you are present. It does not teach the dog to behave in a certain manner when you are absent. Digging and chewing are best addressed by confining your dog in a crate or dog run when you are unable to supervise him.

11. How much time is spent with each dog training?

The length of time for each session varies & depends on where your dog is in our training program. We typically train Monday through Friday & some weekends. Whether we are having a formal training session or not we will be addressing your dog's behavior & listening skills each day.



Y-Farms Training Information

Payment is due at time of drop off

Here at Y-Farms, we customize our training program for each dog. We believe that every dog is unique, so their training should be too! We provide one-on-one training daily. Even when we are not doing formal training, our staff will be correcting/training your dog throughout the day

It typically takes 2 months to have a dog completely obedience trained.

The amount of training time (months) needed is fully dependent on your dog's behavioral issues, learning pace, and ability to take correction.

Puppy Training: \$850.00 / Month

Puppy Obedience Program is dedicated to young dogs (12 weeks - 6 months). This program is designed to give your puppy the perfect training foundation. The puppies are started with basic obedience training. They learn to walk on heel and sit while on a leash, as well as addressing any other issues. Although puppy training will not fix all problems, it will certainly help improve your puppy's manners.

Basic Obedience: \$850.00 / Month

This program is for dogs (6 months or older) who need to learn basic commands and manners. During the month, we will teach your dog our Obedience Training Curriculum, as well as addressing any other issues you might be having at home.

2 Week Tune Up: \$700.00 / 2 Weeks

Our 2 Week Tune Up program is for dogs who have had obedience training in the past. This is a shorter program designed to you give your dog "refresher" on his/her manners, behavior & leash work.

Y-Farms Obedience Training Commands

-**Here**- come to you when called

-**Heel**- “heel” means that your dog must walk directly next to you, not behind or in front of you.

-**No, Sit**- do not jump up, correction that is used for unwanted jumping on a person

-**Kennel**- “kennel” means to have your dog get into his kennel, crate or dog bed. We help your dog understand that the kennel is a safe and comfortable place to be. “Kennel” can be used to get into a truck, crate, or to get on a bed.

-**Sit**- quickly sit and face you perfectly straight, the word “sit” is also used for “stay”

-**Down**- lay “Down” when told

-**Out**- it is time to go outside for playtime or to potty

-**Quiet**- command used for your dog to be silent in his kennel, crate or indoors

-**Drop**- to release, having your dog to let go whatever is in his/her mouth

-**Wait**- “wait” command tells your dog to sit and focus on you, stay where he is and do not move forward until you release him (during food prep or opening a door)

Other types of training we offer with Basic Obedience, at no extra cost: (Request when scheduling)

-**Confidence Building**- We work with shy or anxious dogs to become more confident with themselves, and in new surroundings.

-**E-Collar Training**- We will condition your dog to an electronic collar once they understand the commands we teach. E-collar training is effective in teaching dogs to come when they are called, under all conditions, regardless of the circumstances.

-**Human Aggression/Socialization**- We teach your dog how to behave properly when meeting new people, or when in a group of people.

-**Food Aggression**- We teach your dog to be more comfortable when eating around people/dogs.

-**Yard Digging**- We teach your dog to stop digging in the yard.

-**Counter/Trash Stealing**- We teach your dog to stop stealing food or trash.

-**Swim Lessons**- We will teach your dog to swim. An employee will be in the water with the dog at all times. Swimming lessons are only given at our trainers' discretion and are seasonal.

-**Handling Familiarization**- We will work with your puppy to be comfortable with us touching the mouth, paws, legs, belly, and tail. This is important when working with your dog in the future.

-**Nipping/Biting**- We will teach your dog not to bite or nip at people.

-**Potty Training**- We will encourage your puppy to potty outside and not to potty in their crate or inside the house.
